## Board of Education votes to surplus four former school sites

Dear Jeffco Public Schools Community,

We are writing to inform you about a decision made at the recent board of education meeting regarding several Jeffco properties. On April 11, the Board officially voted to surplus the following four former Jeffco school sites in Lakewood and Arvada:

### Lakewood

- Glennon Heights Elementary
- Vivian Elementary

### Arvada

- Thomson Elementary
- Parr Elementary

This vote triggers the district's property disposition community engagement process (view the Disposition Process flow chart [here](#)). Community meetings will be held for each site to

discuss the disposition process, receive input on potential future uses, and gather feedback from neighbors. Community members, businesses, and nonprofits are encouraged to attend these meetings, which will start in May.

District representatives also will meet with local officials and staff to discuss municipal interest (if any) in the surplus properties, ask for feedback on future uses, and review the city's entitlement and planning process.
